## Holy Toledo – Is That A Sink Hole?

As you probably have noticed, there is an area cordoned off near the concrete sluiceway at the end of the drainage ponds. Please, DO NOT disturb the plywood or caution tape. This area may be unstable as a large amount of dirt has eroded away next to the sluiceway. From the surface, the hole appears relatively minor, but closer inspection shows a very large and deep hole underneath.

The board is working to determine what caused the erosion and what steps need to be taken in order to fix the problem permanently.

Please keep your children and pets away from this area, too. We are not sure if the hole is still expanding, but clearly, it poses a danger to anyone who falls into it or if the hole collapses further.

When a plan is in place to fix the problem, we will let everyone know what will be done and how much it will cost.
